DECISION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT OF
THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA**

**ON THE CASE OF CONFORMITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS STIPULATED BY THE
AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA
AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED ARAB EMIRATES ON COOPERATION
IN SECURITY SERVICES AND COMBATING TERRORISM SIGNED ON 10
NOVEMBER 2016 IN DUBAI WITH THE CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF
ARMENIA**

Proceeding from the results of consideration of the case and ruled by Article 100, Point 2, Article 102, Parts 1 and 4 of the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia, Articles 63, 64 and 72 of the RA Law on the Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court of the Republic of Armenia **HOLDS:**

1. The obligations stipulated by the Agreement on Cooperation in Security Services and Combating Terrorism signed between the Government of the Republic of Armenia and the Government of the United Arab Emirates on November 10, 2016 are in conformity with the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia.
2. Pursuant to Article 102, Part 2 of the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia (with the amendments of 2005) this Decision is final and enters into force from the moment of the announcement.
