ON THE CASE OF CONFORMITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS STIPULATED BY THE PROTOCOL SIGNED IN MOSCOW ON 15 MARCH 2014 ON MAKING AMENDMENTS IN THE TREATY ON THE EURASIAN ECONOMIC UNION OF 29 MAY 2014 WITH THE CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA

Proceeding from the results of consideration of the case and ruled by Point 3 of Article 168, Parts 1 and 4 of Article 170 of the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia and Articles 63, 64 and 74 of the RA Law on the Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court of the Republic of Armenia **HOLDS**:

1. The obligations stipulated in Protocol on Making Amendments and Addenda to the Agreement on International Automobile Communication signed on 20 April 1997 between the Government of the Republic of Armenia and the Government of the Republic of Belarus signed on 29 June 2017 in Yerevan are in conformity with the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia. The obligations stipulated in the Protocol signed in Moscow on 15 March 2014 on making amendments in the Treaty on the Eurasian Economic Union of 29 May 2014 are in conformity with the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia.

2. Pursuant to Part 2 of Article 170 of the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia this Decision is final and enters into force upon promulgation.
