DECISION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT OF
THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA**

**ON THE CASE OF CONFORMITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS STIPULATED BY THE
PROTOCOL ON MAKING AMENDMENTS TO THE AGREEMENT ON COOPERATION
IN THE FIELD OF MILITARY COURIER POSTAL COMMUNICATION BETWEEN
THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA AND THE GOVERNMENT OF
THE RUSSIAN FEDERATION SIGNED ON DECEMBER 27, 2018 BETWEEN THE
GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE
RUSSIAN FEDERATION WITH THE CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF
ARMENIA**

Based on the review of the case and governed by clause 3 of article 168, parts 1 and 4 of article 170 of the Constitution, articles 63, 64 and 74 of the Constitutional Law on the Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court **HOLDS:**

1. The obligations stipulated by the Protocol on Making Amendments to the Agreement on Cooperation in the Field of Military Courier Postal Communication between the Government of the Republic of Armenia and the Government of the Russian Federation signed on December 27, 2018 between the Government of the Republic of Armenia and the Government of the Russian Federation are in conformity with the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia.

2. Pursuant to part 2 of article 170 of the Constitution this Decision shall be final and shall enter into force upon its promulgation.
