DECISION OF CONSTITUTIONAL COURT OF  
THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA**

**ON THE CASE OF CONFORMITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS STIPULATED IN THE AGREEMENT ON AIR COMMUNICATION BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE HASHEMITE KINGDOM OF JORDAN SIGNED IN AMMAN ON NOVEMBER 1, 2018 WITH THE CONSTITUTION**

Based on the review of the case and governed by clause 3 of article 168, parts 1 and 4 of article 170 of the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia, articles 63, 64 and 74 of the Constitutional Law on the Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court **HOLDS**:

1. The obligations stipulated in the Agreement on Air Communication between the Government of Republic of Armenia and the Government of the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan signed in Amman on November 1, 2018 signed on November 2, 2018 are in conformity with the Constitution.

2. Pursuant to part 2 of article 170 of the Constitution this Decision shall be final and shall enter into force upon its promulgation.
