

**IN THE NAME OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA
DECISION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT OF
THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA**

ON THE CASE OF CONFORMITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS STIPULATED IN TREATY ON FINANCIAL COOPERATION OF 2016, SIGNED BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF GERMANY SIGNED ON OCTOBER 24, 2019 WITH THE CONSTITUTION

Based on the review of the case and governed by clause 3 of article 168, parts 1 and 4 of article 170 of the Constitution, articles 63, 64 and 74 of the Constitutional Law on the Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court **HOLDS:**

1. The obligations stipulated in Treaty on Financial Cooperation of 2016, signed between the Government of the Republic of Armenia and the Government of the Federal Republic of Germany signed on October 24, 2019 are in conformity with the Constitution.

2. Pursuant to part 2 of article 170 of the Constitution this Decision shall be final and shall enter into force upon its promulgation.
