DECISION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT OF
THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA**

ON THE CASE OF CONFORMITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS STIPULATED IN THE PROTOCOL SIGNED IN MOSCOW ON 3 DECEMBER 2018 ON JOINING THE AGREEMENT ON PROCEDURE FOR CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION PROTECTION AND LIABILITY FOR ITS DISCLOSURE IN THE IMPLEMENTATION BY THE EURASIAN ECONOMIC COMMISSION OF THE POWERS TO CONTROL COMPLIANCE WITH THE GENERAL RULES OF COMPETITION SIGNED ON 12 NOVEMBER 2014 WITH THE CONSTITUTION

Based on the review of the case and governed by clause 3 of article 168, parts 1 and 4 of article 170 of the Constitution, articles 63, 64 and 74 of the Constitutional Law on the Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court **HOLDS**:

1. The obligations stipulated in the Protocol signed in Moscow on 3 December 2018 on joining the Agreement on Procedure for Confidential Information Protection and Liability for its Disclosure in the Implementation by the Eurasian Economic Commission of the Powers to Control Compliance with the General Rules of Competition signed on 12 November 2014 are in conformity with the Constitution.

2. Pursuant to part 2 of article 170 of the Constitution this Decision shall be final and shall enter into force upon its promulgation.
