DECISION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT OF
THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA**

**ON THE CASE OF CONFORMITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS STIPULATED IN THE
AGREEMENT ON TRADE IN SERVICES AND INVESTMENT BETWEEN THE
REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA AND THE REPUBLIC OF SINGAPORE SIGNED ON 1
OCTOBER 2019 IN YEREVAN WITH THE CONSTITUTION**

Based on the review of the case and governed by clause 3 of article 168, parts 1 and 4 of article 170 of the Constitution, articles 63, 64 and 74 of the Constitutional Law on the Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court **HOLDS:**

1. The obligations stipulated in the Agreement on Trade in Services and Investment between the Republic of Armenia and the Republic of Singapore signed on 1 October 2019 in Yerevan are in conformity with the Constitution.

2. Pursuant to part 2 of article 170 of the Constitution this Decision shall be final and shall enter into force upon its promulgation.
