

**IN THE NAME OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA
DECISION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT OF
THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA**

**ON THE CASE OF CONFORMITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS STIPULATED IN THE
TREATY ON TRADEMARKS, SERVICE MARKS AND APPELLATION OF ORIGIN OF
THE GOODS SIGNED IN MOSCOW ON 3 FEBRUARY 2020 WITH THE
CONSTITUTION**

Based on the review of the case and governed by clause 3 of article 168, parts 1 and 4 of article 170 of the Constitution, articles 63, 64 and 74 of the Constitutional Law on the Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court **HOLDS**:

1. The obligations stipulated in the treaty on Trademarks, Service Marks and Appellation of Origin of the Goods signed in Moscow on 3 February 2020 is in conformity with the Constitution.
2. Pursuant to part 2 of article 170 of the Constitution this Decision is final and shall enter into force upon its promulgation.
