

**IN THE NAME OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA  
DECISION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT OF  
THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA**

**ON THE CASE OF CONFORMITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS STIPULATED IN  
AGREEMENT ON SECOND OPTIONAL PROTOCOL TO THE INTERNATIONAL  
COVENANT ON CIVIL AND POLITICAL RIGHTS, AIMING AT THE ABOLITION OF  
THE DEATH PENALTY SIGNED ON 15 DECEMBER 1989 WITH THE CONSTITUTION**

Based on the review of the case and governed by clause 3 of article 168, parts 1 and 4 of article 170 of the Constitution, articles 63, 64 and 74 of the Constitutional Law on the Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court **HOLDS:**

1. The obligations stipulated in Agreement on Second Optional Protocol to the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights, Aiming at the Abolition of the Death Penalty signed on 15 December 1989 are in conformity with the Constitution.

2. Pursuant to part 2 of article 170 of the Constitution this Decision is final and shall enter into force upon its promulgation.
