

**IN THE NAME OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA
DECISION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT OF
THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA**

**ON THE CASE OF CONFORMITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS STIPULATED IN THE
AGREEMENT SIGNED IN ROME ON 22 NOVEMBER 2019 BETWEEN THE REPUBLIC OF
ARMENIA AND THE REPUBLIC OF ITALY AIMED AT FACILITATING THE
APPLICATION OF THE EUROPEAN CONVENTION ON MUTUAL ASSISTANCE IN
CRIMINAL MATTERS OF 20 APRIL 1959 WITH THE CONSTITUTION**

Based on the review of the case and governed by Clause 3 of Article 168, Parts 1 and 4 of Article 170 of the Constitution, as well as Articles 63, 64 and 74 of the Constitutional Law on the Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court **HOLDS:**

1. The obligations stipulated in the Agreement signed in Rome on 22 November 2019 between the Republic of Armenia and the Republic of Italy Aimed at Facilitating the Application of the European Convention on Mutual Assistance in Criminal Matters of 20 April 1959 are in conformity with the Constitution.

2. Pursuant to Part 2 of Article 170 of the Constitution this Decision shall be final and shall enter into force upon its promulgation.
