

**IN THE NAME OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA  
DECISION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT OF  
THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA**

**ON THE CASE OF CONFORMITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS STIPULATED IN THE  
AGREEMENT ON THE PROCEDURE FOR THE CIRCULATION OF PRODUCTS NOT  
REGULATED BY TECHNICAL REGULATIONS OF THE EURASIAN ECONOMIC UNION  
AND SAFETY RULES FOR SUCH PRODUCT WITHIN THE EURASIAN ECONOMIC UNION  
WITH THE CONSTITUTION**

Based on the review of the case and governed by Clause 3 of Article 168, Parts 1 and 4 of Article 170 of the Constitution, as well as Articles 63, 64 and 74 of the Constitutional Law on the Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court **HOLDS:**

**1.** The obligations stipulated in the Agreement on the Procedure for the Circulation of Products not Regulated by Technical Regulations of the Eurasian Economic Union and Safety Rules for Such Product within the Eurasian Economic Union are in conformity with the Constitution.

**2.** Pursuant to Part 2 of Article 170 of the Constitution this Decision shall be final and shall enter into force upon its promulgation.
