ON THE CASE OF CONFORMITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS PRESCRIBED BY THE CONVENTION BETWEEN STATES PARTIES TO THE COMMONWEALTH OF INDEPENDENT STATES ON COOPERATION IN PEACEFUL EXPLORATION AND USE OF OUTER SPACE SIGNED IN DUSHANBE ON 28 SEPTEMBER 2018 WITH THE CONSTITUTION

Based on the review of the case and governed by Clause 3 of Article 168, Parts 1 and 4 of Article 170 of the Constitution, as well as Articles 63, 64 and 74 of the Constitutional Law on the Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court **HOLDS**:

- 1. The obligations prescribed by the Convention between States Parties to the Commonwealth of Independent States on Cooperation in Peaceful Exploration and Use of Outer Space signed in Dushanbe on 28 September 2018 are in conformity with the Constitution.
- **2.** Pursuant to Part 2 of Article 170 of the Constitution this Decision shall be final and shall enter into force upon its promulgation.
