

**IN THE NAME OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA
DECISION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT OF
THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA**

**ON THE CASE OF CONFORMITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS PRESCRIBED BY THE
AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA AND THE CZECH REPUBLIC ON
FACILITATING THE APPLICATION OF THE EUROPEAN CONVENTION ON
EXTRADITION OF 13 DECEMBER 1957 WITH THE CONSTITUTION**

Based on the review of the case and governed by Clause 3 of Article 168, Parts 1 and 4 of Article 170 of the Constitution, as well as Articles 63, 64 and 74 of the Constitutional Law on the Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court **HOLDS:**

1. The obligation prescribed by the Agreement between the Republic of Armenia and the Czech Republic on Facilitating the Application of the European Convention on Extradition of 13 December 1957 contradicts the Constitution.

2. Pursuant to Part 2 of Article 170 of the Constitution this Decision shall be final and shall enter into force upon its promulgation.
