## IN THE NAME OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA DECISION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA

ON THE CASE OF CONFORMITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS PRESCRIBED BY THE PROTOCOL ON MAKING AMENDMENTS TO THE AGREEMENT OF 25 NOVEMBER 2005 ON COOPERATION AMONG THE CIS MEMBER STATES IN THE FIGHT AGAINST PLUNDERS OF VEHICLES AND ENSURING THEIR RETURN WITH THE CONSTITUTION

Based on the review of the case and governed by Clause 3 of Article 168, Parts 1 and 4 of Article 170 of the Constitution, as well as Articles 63, 64 and 74 of the Constitutional Law on the Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court **HOLDS**:

- 1. The obligations prescribed by the Protocol on Making Amendments to the Agreement of 25 November 2005 on Cooperation among CIS Member States in the Fight against Plunders of Vehicles and Ensuring their Return are in conformity with the Constitution.
- **2.** Pursuant to Part 2 of Article 170 of the Constitution this Decision shall be final and shall enter into force upon its promulgation.
