DECISION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT OF
THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA**

**ON THE CASE CONCERNING THE CONSTITUTIONALITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS
PRESCRIBED BY THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE
REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE HELLENIC REPUBLIC
ON MILITARY-TECHNICAL COOPERATION SIGNED IN ATHENS ON 14
DECEMBER 2023**

Based on the examination of the case and subject to Article 168(3), and Article 170 §§ 1 and 4 of the Constitution, as well as guided by Articles 63, 64 and 74 of the Constitutional Law on the Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court **HOLDS:**

1. The obligations prescribed by the Agreement Between the Government of the Republic of Armenia and the Government of the Hellenic Republic on Military-Technical Cooperation signed in Athens on 14 December 2023 comply with the Constitution.

2. Pursuant to Article 170 § 2 of the Constitution, this Decision shall be final and shall enter into force upon its promulgation.
