ON THE CASE CONCERNING THE CONSTITUTIONALITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS PRESCRIBED BY THE PROTOCOL ON THE TERMINATION OF MULTILATERAL AGREEMENTS SIGNED WITHIN THE FRAMEWORK OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF INDEPENDENT STATES SIGNED ON 14 DECEMBER 2000

Based on the examination of the case and subject to Article 168(3), and Article 170 §§ 1 and 4 of the Constitution, as well as guided by Articles 63, 64 and 74 of the Constitutional Law on the Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court **HOLDS**:

- 1. The obligations prescribed by the Protocol on the Termination of Multilateral Agreements Signed within the Framework of the Commonwealth of Independent States signed on 14 December 2000 comply with the Constitution.
- **2.** Pursuant to Article 170 § 2 of the Constitution, this Decision shall be final and shall enter into force upon its promulgation.
