DECISION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT OF  
THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA**

**ON THE CASE CONCERNING THE CONSTITUTIONALITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS  
PRESCRIBED BY THE PROTOCOL AMENDING THE AGREEMENT ON TRADE-  
RELATED ASPECTS OF INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS SIGNED IN GENEVA  
ON 6 DECEMBER 2005**

Based on the examination of the case and subject to Article 168(3), and Article 170 §§ 1 and 4 of the Constitution, as well as guided by Articles 63, 64 and 74 of the Constitutional Law on the Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court **HOLDS:**

**1.** The obligations prescribed by the Protocol Amending the Agreement on Trade-Related Aspects of Intellectual Property Rights signed in Geneva on December 6, 2005 comply with the Constitution.

**2.** Pursuant to Article 170 § 2 of the Constitution, this Decision shall be final and shall enter into force upon its promulgation.
