AUTHORITIES OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA COMPETENT FOR JUDICIAL

COOPERATION IN CRIMINAL MATTERS SIGNED IN BRUSSELS ON 5 APRIL 2024

Based on the examination of the case and subject to Article 168(3), and Article 170 §§ 1

and 4 of the Constitution, as well as guided by Articles 63, 64 and 74 of the Constitutional Law on

the Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court HOLDS:

1. The obligations prescribed by the Agreement Between the European Union and the

Republic of Armenia on the Cooperation Between the European Union Agency for Criminal

Justice Cooperation (Eurojust) and the Authorities of the Republic of Armenia Competent for

Judicial Cooperation in Criminal Matters signed in Brussels on 5 April 2024 comply with the

Constitution.

2. Pursuant to Article 170 § 2 of the Constitution, this Decision shall be final and shall

enter into force upon its promulgation.
