## IN THE NAME OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA DECISION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA

## ON THE CASE CONCERNING THE CONSTITUTIONALITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS PRESCRIBED BY THE CONVENTIONS FOR THE PACIFIC SETTLEMENT OF INTERNATIONAL DISPUTES ADOPTED AT THE HAGUE ON 29 JULY 1899 AND 18 OCTOBER 1907

Based on the results of an examination of the Case and guided by point 3 of Article 168, parts 1 and 4 of Article 170 of the Constitution, as well as Articles 63, 64, and 74 of the Constitutional Law "On the Constitutional Court", the Constitutional Court **DECIDED:** 

- 1. The obligations prescribed by the Conventions for the Pacific Settlement of International Disputes adopted at The Hague on 29 July 1899 and 18 October 1907, comply with the Constitution.
- **2.** According to part 2 of Article 170 of the Constitution, this Decision shall be final and enter into force upon its promulgation.
