DECISION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT OF
THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA**

ON THE CASE CONCERNING THE DETERMINATION OF THE ISSUE REGARDING THE CONFORMITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS STIPULATED BY THE COUNCIL OF EUROPE CONVENTION ON ACTION AGAINST TRAFFICKING IN HUMAN BEINGS SIGNED ON 16 MAY 2005 IN WARSAW WITH THE CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA

Proceeding from the results of hearing of the case and ruled by Article 100(2), Parts 2 and 4, Article 102 of the Constitution, Articles 63, 64 and 72 of the Law on Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court of the Republic of Armenia **DECIDES:**

1. The obligations set forth in Convention of the Council of Europe on Action against Trafficking of Human Beings, signed on 16 May 2005, are in conformity with the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia.
2. In accordance with Part 2, Article 102 of the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia this decision is final and enters into force from the moment of announcement.
