DECISION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT OF  
THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA**

**ON THE CASE CONCERNING THE DETERMINATION OF THE ISSUE REGARDING THE CONFORMITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS STIPULATED BY THE PROTOCOL ON ACCESSION OF THE REPUBLIC OF BULGARIA AND ROMANIA TO THE PARTNERSHIP AND COOPERATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA OF THE ONE PART, AND THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES AND THEIR MEMBER STATES OF THE OTHER PART, SIGNED ON 27 JUNE 2007 IN BRUSSELS WITH THE CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA**

Based on the results of the hearing and ruled by Point 2, Article 100, Parts 1 and 4, Article 102 of the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia, Articles 63 and 64 of the Law of the Republic of Armenia on “The Constitutional Court”, the Constitutional Court of the Republic of Armenia **H E L D:**

1. the obligations stipulated by the Protocol on Accession of the Republic of Bulgaria and Romania to the Partnership and Cooperation Agreement between the Republic Of Armenia of the One Part, and the European Communities and their Member States of the Other Part, signed On 27 June 2007 in Brussels are in conformity with the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia.
2. Pursuant to Part 2, Article 102 of the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia this decision is final and enters into force from the date of publication.
