DECISION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT OF
THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA**

ON THE CASE CONCERNING THE DETERMINATION OF THE ISSUE REGARDING THE CONFORMITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS STIPULATED BY THE AGREEMENT ON COOPERATION FOR DEVELOPMENT SIGNED ON 15 SEPTEMBER 2008 IN YEREVAN BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE KINGDOM OF DENMARK WITH THE CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA

Based on the results of the hearing and ruled by Point 2, Article 100, Parts 1 and 4, Article 102 of the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia, Articles 63 and 64 of the Law of the Republic of Armenia on “The Constitutional Court”, the Constitutional Court of the Republic of Armenia **H E L D:**

1. the obligations stipulated by the Agreement On Cooperation for Development signed on 15 September 2008 in Yerevan between the Government of the Republic of Armenia and the Government of the Kingdom of Denmark are in conformity with the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia.
2. Pursuant to Part 2, Article 102 of the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia this decision is final and enters into force from the date of publication.
