ON THE CASE CONCERNING THE DETERMINATION OF THE ISSUE REGARDING THE CONFORMITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS STIPULATED BY THE FINANCING AGREEMENT ON LIFELINE ROADS IMPROVEMENT PROJECT SIGNED ON 26 FEBRUARY 2009 BETWEEN THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA AND THE INTERNATIONAL DEVELOPMENT ASSOCIATION WITH THE CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA

Considering the results of the examination of the case and guided by Article 100(2), Parts 2 and 4, Article 102 of the Constitution, Articles 63, 64 and 72 of the Law on "The Constitutional Court," the Constitutional Court of the Republic of Armenia **DECIDES:**

1. The obligations stipulated by the Financing Agreement on Lifeline roads improvement project signed on 26 February 2009 between the Republic of Armenia and the International Development Association are in conformity with the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia.
2. Pursuant to Part 2, Article 102 of the RA Constitution this decision is final and enters into force from the date of publication.
