DECISION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT OF
THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA**

ON THE CASE CONCERNING THE DETERMINATION OF THE ISSUE REGARDING THE CONFORMITY OF PART 4, POINT 5, ARTICLE 55 OF THE CRIMINAL PROCEDURE CODE, PART 6, ARTICLE 1 OF THE RA LAW ON “THE ORGANAZATION AND PERFORMANCE OF INSPECTIONS IN THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA”, PART 4, ARTICLE 2 OF THE RA LAW ON “THE PRINCIPLES OF ADMINISTRATION AND ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE” WITH THE CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA ON THE BASIS OF THE APPLICATION OF THE RA ADMINISTRATIVE COURT

Based on the results of the consideration of the case and in accordance with Point 1, Article 100, Article 102 of the Constitution, Point 1, Article 60, Articles 63, 64 and 71 of the RA Law on “The Constitutional Court”, the Constitutional Court of the Republic of Armenia **DECIDED:**

1. To dismiss the proceedings filed on the basis of the application of the RA Administrative Court regarding the interpretation of the law enforcement practice stipulated Part 6, Article 1 of the RA Law "On the Organization and Conduct of Inspections in the Republic of Armenia" and Part 4, Article 2 of the RA Law "On Principles of Administration and Administrative Proceedings".
2. Point 5, Part 4, Article 55 of the RA Criminal Procedure Code is in conformity with the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia.
3. Pursuant to Part 5, Article of the RA Constitution, this decision is final and enters into force from the date of publication.
