DECISION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT OF  
THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA**

**ON THE CASE CONCERNING THE DETERMINATION OF THE ISSUE REGARDING THE CONFORMITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS STIPULATED BY THE AGREEMENT ON MUTUAL PROVISION OF BUILDINGS AND GROUND AREAS FOR ESTABLISHMENT OF EMBASSIES SIGNED ON 21 JUNE 2009 IN YEREVAN BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED ARAB EMIRATES WITH THE CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA**

Based on the results of the hearing and ruled by Article 100 Point 1, Article 102 of the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia, Article 63, 64 and 69 of the Law of the Republic of Armenia on “The Constitutional Court”, the Constitutional Court of the Republic of Armenia **H E L D:**

1. the obligations stipulated by the Agreement on Mutual Provision of Buildings and Ground Areas for Establishment of Embassies signed on 21 June 2009 in Yerevan between the Government of the Republic of Armenia and the Government of the United Arab Emirates are in conformity with the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia.
2. Pursuant to Part 2, Article 102 of the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia, this decision is final and enters into force from the date of publication.
