

**IN THE NAME OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA
DECISION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT OF
THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA**

ON THE CASE CONCERNING THE DETERMINATION OF THE ISSUE REGARDING THE CONFORMITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS STIPULATED BY THE AGREEMENT ON MUTUAL ESTABLISHMENT OF THE TRADE REPRESENTATIONS BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE RUSSIAN FEDERATION SIGNED ON AUGUST 20, 2010 IN YEREVAN WITH THE CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA

Based on the review of the Case and being governed by Article 100, Point 2, Article 102, Parts 1 and 4 of the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia, Articles 63 and 64 of the RA Law on the Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court of the Republic of Armenia **HOLDS:**

1. The obligations stipulated by the Agreement on Mutual Establishment of the Trade Representations between the Government of the Republic of Armenia and the Government of the Russian Federation signed on 20 August, 2010 in Yerevan, are in conformity with the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia.
2. Pursuant to Article 102, Part 2 of the RA Constitution this Decision is final and enters into force from the moment of its announcement.
