DECISION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT OF
THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA**

ON THE CASE CONCERNING THE DETERMINATION OF THE ISSUE REGARDING THE CONFORMITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA STIPULATED IN THE COUNCIL OF EUROPE FRAMEWORK CONVENTION ON THE VALUE OF THE CULTURAL HERITAGE FOR SOCIETY SIGNED ON OCTOBER 27, 2005, IN FARO WITH THE CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA

Proceeding from the results of examination of the case and ruled by Article 100(2), Parts 2 and 4, Article 102 of the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia, Articles 63, 64 and 72 of the RA Law on “The Constitutional Court”, the Constitutional Court of the Republic of Armenia **DECIDES:**

1. The obligations, set forth in the Council of Europe Framework Convention on the Value of the Cultural Heritage for Society signed on October 27, 2005, in Faro, are in conformity with the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia.
2. In accordance with Article 102(2) of the RA Constitution this decision is final and enters into force from the moment of its announcement.
