DECISION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT OF
THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA**

**ON THE CASE ON CONFORMITY OF ARTICLE 14, PART 3, POINT 4 OF THE LAW OF
THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA "ON THE JUDICIAL SERVICE" WITH THE
CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA ON THE BASIS OF THE
APPLICATION OF THE CITIZEN ARMEN KHARATYAN**

Proceeding from the results of consideration of the case and being ruled by provisions of Article 100, Part 1 and Article 102 of the Constitution, Articles 19, 63, 64 and 69 of the RA Law on “The Constitutional Court”, the Constitutional Court of the Republic of Armenia **HOLDS:**

1. Article 14, Part 3, Point 4 of the Law of the Republic of Armenia on Judicial Service, taking into account the legal positions stated in this Decision, and considering that the legal regulation pursues a legitimate aim for promotion of independence of the judge and effectiveness of his/her activities, is in conformity with the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia.

2. Pursuant to Article 102, Part 2 of the RA Constitution this Decision is final and enters into force from the moment of its announcement.
