DECISION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT OF
THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA**

**ON THE CASE OF CONFORMITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS STIPULATED BY THE
TREATY ON MUTUAL LEGAL ASSISTANCE IN CRIMINAL MATTERS SIGNED
BETWEEN THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA AND THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA
ON 25 MARCH 2015 IN BEIJING WITH THE CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF
ARMENIA**

Based on the results of the consideration of the Case and ruled by Article 100, Point 2, Article 102, Part 1, Point 4 of the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia, Articles 63,64 and 72 of the Law of the Republic of Armenia on Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court of the Republic of Armenia **HOLDS:**

1. The Protocol “Treaty on Mutual Legal Assistance in Criminal Matters” signed between the Republic of Armenia and the People's Republic of China in Beijing on March 25, 2015 is in conformity with the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia
2. Pursuant to Article 102, Part 2 of the RA Constitution this Decision is final and enters into force from the moment of its announcement.
