**ON THE CASE OF CONFORMITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS STIPULATED BY THE  
PROTOCOL No. 15 AMENDING THE CONVENTION ON THE PROTECTION OF HUMAN  
RIGHTS AND FUNDAMENTAL FREEDOMS SIGNED ON JUNE 24, 2013 IN STRASBOURG  
WITH THE CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA**

Proceeding from the results of consideration of the case and ruled by Article 100 (2), Article 102, Parts 1 and 4 of the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia, Articles 63, 64 and 72 of the RA Law on Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court of the Republic of Armenia **HOLDS:**

1. The obligations set forth in the Protocol No.15 on Amending the Convention on the Protection of Human Rights and Fundamental Freedoms signed on June 24, 2015 are in conformity with the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia.
2. In accordance with Article 102 (2) of the RA Constitution this decision is final and enters into force from the moment of its announcement.
